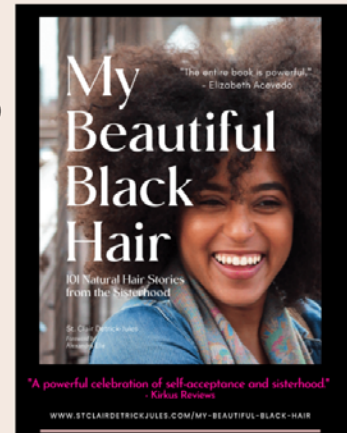

FROM THE AUTHOR: My talk will focus on what I've learned through my almost four-year-long journey photographing and interviewing 101 Black women with natural hair for my debut photojournalism book, *My Beautiful Black Hair: 101 Natural Hair Stories from the Sisterhood*, which explores the deep, complex relationships across generations between the Black community and our hair. I invite audience members of all ages and backgrounds to think about the ways in which we can use conversations about Black hair as an entry-point into related topics, including (but not limited to) self-love, community care, radical joy, and anti-racism work. I also offer a blueprint for using narrative storytelling — reclaiming our voices both on an individual level and on a communal level — as a form of social activism.
